4	Section 1. Authority. The Town of Waitsfield adopted this ordinance under the authority of 20 V S A & Chapter 50

о 7	Section 2. Purpose.
8	The purpose of this ordinance is to establish and maintain an effective program of ordinance
9	enforcement.
10	
11	Section 3. Enforcement Officers.
12	The Town of Waitsfield may designate as an enforcement officer any of the following municipal
13	officials: Selectboard Chair, Town Administrator, Zoning Administrator, Assistant Zoning
14	Administrator, Town Clerk, Town Health Officer, Dog Warden, a certified law enforcement
15	officer.
16	
17	Nothing in this section is intended to limit the appointment of enforcement officers. The
18	Selectboard shall make all appointments of municipal officials.
19	
20	Section 4. Enforcement.
21	The violations of ordinances shall be considered civil matters, which may be enforced in the
22	Vermont Judicial Bureau or in the Washington County Superior Court, at the election of the
23	Selectboard.
24 25	For the numbers of enforcement in the Indiaial Dursey, the following enforcement officers may
25 26	For the purposes of enforcement in the Judicial Bureau, the following enforcement officers may issue tickets and serve as the appearing officer at any hearing:

28	a) Zoning and Subdivision Ordinances – the zoning administrator and assistant
29	zoning administrator.
30	b) <i>Traffic Ordinance</i> – a certified law enforcement officer, including but not limited
31	to local police, constables, Vermont State Police, and the Washington County
32	Sheriff's Department.
33	c) <i>Dog Ordinance</i> – the dog warden and town health officer.
34	d) Garage Sale and Itinerant Vendor Ordinances – the town administrator and town
35	clerk.
36	e) Public Festival Ordinance – the town administrator.
37	f) Street Naming and Addressing Ordinance – the zoning administrator and the town
38	administrator.
39	g) <i>Water Ordinance</i> – the designee(s) of the Water Commission and the town
40	administrator.
41	h) Any public health or similar ordinance – the town health officer.
42	
43	The Selectboard may appoint an interim enforcement officer for one or more of the ordinances
44	listed to fill a vacancy until a regular enforcement officer is appointed.

- 46 Violations enforced in Superior Court shall be in accordance with the Vermont Rules of Civil
- 47 Procedure.

- 49 In addition to the enforcement procedures available before the Judicial Bureau, the Town
- 50 Administrator may, following authorization from the Selectboard, commence a civil action to
- 51 obtain injunctive relief and other appropriate relief, or to pursue any other remedy authorized by
- 52 law.

- 54 <u>Section 5. Training for Enforcement Officers.</u>
- 55 Before any enforcement officer issues a penalty for violation of an ordinance, they shall have
- successfully completed training on the enforcement process and protocols. The Board will
- 57 determine what training is required, and shall certify that the enforcement officer has
- 58 successfully completed said training.
